Curtin Primary School invites artists to enter their works for exhibition and sale at its 2nd Annual Art Show. The opening night will include drinks, canapés and entertainment.

Curtin Primary is a large school in inner Canberra, with 450 students. The show will help to promote art within the school and around the local communities. Funds raised will support art projects for the children at Curtin Primary School.

Conditions for exhibition of work

1. All work must be the original work of the named exhibitor. Prints or copies of an artist's work will not be acceptable.
2. Entry fees are \$10 for the first work and \$7 for any subsequent pieces (limit of 3 pieces). Entry fees include a ticket to the opening night.
Children's entries (Preschool to Year 10) are \$5.
Fees are payable to Curtin Primary School P&C Committee on registration.
3. **Entries close 3pm, Friday 27 April.** Exhibitors must provide a complete list of works, including prices, on the Art Registration Form. Forms can be mailed to Curtin Primary Art Show, c/- 16 McCulloch St Curtin ACT 2605, faxed on 6162 2588 or emailed to curtinartshow@gmail.com. Payment is required on registration.
4. We provide a folder of artists **CVs** for potential buyers to view. Please provide a CV with your **Entry form**. As well as information on your background and experience, your CV should include details of prizes won, one-person exhibitions, shows entered, excerpts from reviews, etc
5. Artworks will be for sale at the show. The Curtin Primary P&C Committee will retain a commission of 20% of the sale price of each work sold. Cheques will be issued to artists whose work has been sold as soon as possible after the completion of the art show.
6. By signing and submitting the application to display and sell work, the exhibitor expressly acknowledges and agrees that their work is to be exhibited at their own risk, and that no member of the Curtin Primary P&C Committee, nor any member of the Curtin Primary School staff shall be in any way responsible for the loss or damage to work, however or by whomsoever that loss or damage may be caused.
7. The committee reserves the right to reject any work that is not framed professionally or in which the framing is fragile or not secured properly. Due care will be taken; however, framing is the responsibility of the artist, even after the work is sold. All paintings must have a string or wire linked by two hooks for secure hanging.
8. The committee reserves the right to reject or restrict any exhibit or exhibitor. A limit of three paintings per artist will be accepted. Size restrictions may apply.
9. **DELIVERY** – Exhibits are to be delivered to the Curtin Primary School multipurpose hall on Wednesday 16 May between 4pm and 6pm. And Thursday 17 May between 8am and 10am.
10. **COLLECTION** – All unsold exhibits are to be collected on Sunday 20 May between 2pm and 5pm. Agents acting on behalf of exhibitors will need authorisation to collect works.
11. Prizes – all open artworks will be entered into a People's Choice Award. Children's entries will be judged, with 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes to be awarded.
12. Photos taken at the Art Show may be used for future promotion of the show. Every attempt will be made to contact the artists for future use of images. Photos of art will be credited to the relevant artist.
